## Fundraising for wounded soldiers from the Iraq War

In conjunction with the History Club at Spotswood High School and through its club advisor, Frank Yusko, River Mill Art Gallery will conduct a fundraising sale to help assist wounded soldiers who have returned (and are returning) from Iraq. These funds will allow the club to purchase "recovery packages" for the soldiers. The packages consist of various items that will help the soldiers make the transition into "living at home" again – items such as toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, shaving cream, etc.), clothing (sweaters, shirts, pants, and the like), books, and entertainment. Each package costs approximately \$100.

Our goal is to raise enough funds to purchase several packages.

Starts Friday, January 26 to Saturday, February 3; selected items such as jewelry, prints, and posters (framed and unframed) will be drastically reduced (50 - 80% off). All proceeds from the sale will go toward the fundraising effort.

In addition, Ken Horowitz Photographic Services of NYC has donated six prints by award winning photojournalist Nina Berman. These are works from her Purple Hearts Project - a photographic documentary on the wounded soldiers from the Iraq War. The matted and framed prints are to be sold for \$99 each.
